4. The assessment report along with the clarification was duly placed in the 135th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 18.07.2025 and Board concluded that the college is fulfilling the notified & requisite approved criteria for issuance of permission as per the concerned Acts and regulations. Hence, the Board decided to issue the 2nd renewal of permission in accordance with Regulation 64 (3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 as per the Board policy letter dated 20.01.2025 with an intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.

"DECISION"

5. Therefore, 2nd Renewal of permission is hereby granted to Indutai Gaikwad Patil Ayurvedic College & Research Center, Survey No. 26, At. Dhuti, Dongargoan, Wardha Road, Nagpur-441108, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0838) with an intake capacity of 100 seats in the UG (BAMS) course in accordance with Regulation 64 (3) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 for the academic session 2025-26 under section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that following requirements shall be fulfilled: -

I. It is informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 100 seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

II. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.

6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.

7. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARSISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.
